Media Storm

\$3,400 (50% travel match)

Media Storm is requesting funding for travel for 10 students to attend the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) conferences in Las Vegas on April 6-11, 2019. Students would contribute \$200-300 each to secure their spot. The cost of the trip is \$6,800. They are requesting 50% of that for a total of \$3,400.

Sue Schmitz made a motion to increase and approve the request to \$8000 and match 50% at \$4,000, Kinsey seconded. Motion passed. Dylan abstained from voting.

Hands On Ink

\$19,000

Hands On Ink is a new club out of the Graphic Design program. They are requesting funding for two pieces of equipment that can be used for making custom apparel with a direct to garment printer for a total of \$19,000. The equipment could be used by other clubs for fundraising events or club wear.

Sheila made a motion to table this request until Marketing, Student Life, and the club meet to come up with guidelines about use of this machine and to possibly have Marketing help with the cost as it could be used by the college as well. James seconded. Motion passed.
